

SPECIAL EMERGENCY MEETING OF THE SPRAGUE WATER AND SEWER AUTHORITY

Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. by Chairman Dennison Allen.

Discuss and possibly act on repairs to water leak between the shut off valve and the Town of Sprague elementary school known as Sayles School:

Dennison Allen addressed the board members and informed them of the emergency situation that needed our attention at the Sayles elementary school regarding a water main line break. He gave the board members all the pertinent information and told them of his meeting with the School Superintendent, Dr. Judy Benson-Clarke. Handouts from Wright Pierce were given out and discussion followed. Wright Pierce has made recommendations on the fix for this problem based on their evaluation of the area and problem. More discussion. Responsibility for payment of this fix was also discussed. Based on the Sprague Water & Sewer Authority water regulations if after investigating a problem and it is determined that the repair is not the responsibility of the Sprague Water & Sewer Authority but the owner's responsibility, The Sprague Water & Sewer Authority will cease its work. It is, at that time, up to the owner to either ask the Water & Sewer Authority to continue to work with their contractor at the owner's expense or call their own contractor to repair the problem (In this case all expenses from the initiation of the work will be borne by the owner). The Sprague Water & Sewer Authority must be called in to inspect the work. It was the consensus of the board members that the responsibility for payment for fixing this problem falls upon the Board of Education for Sayles School.

Kathleen informed the board members that a meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, March 9, 2016 at 5:30 p.m. this afternoon called the Dr, Judy Benson-Clarke with the Board of Education members to discuss this repair. Board members of the Sprague Water & Sewer Authority were invited to attend. It was decided that Dennison Allen would be at the meeting along with our engineer Brian Messner from Wright Pierce to explain to the members of the Board of Education and the Superintendent Dr. Benson-Clarke of the evaluation of the situation and the recommended fix for this problem.
