

**ADOPTED AMENDMENT/ SUPPLEMENT TO THE
SPRAGUE PLAN OF CONSERVATION AND DEVELOPMENT**

The Sprague Planning and Zoning Commission adopted the following supplement to its existing Plan of Conservation and Development, dated May 5, 2007. The effective date of this amendment is August 1, 2012.

It is the intent of the Planning and Zoning Commission to make agriculture an additional major plan goal. In terms of Section XI., Generalized Land Use Plan, C., Major Plan Goals, of the existing plan the Commission adopted the following addition:

- Promote farming and agriculture as part of an overall plan to protect and preserve Sprague’s existing open space plan and to enhance the town’s economic and commercial base through agriculture related businesses. Through a public awareness campaign and advertising and other means, make public Sprague’s plan to encourage farming and business related agriculture by the implementation of less restrictive farming and agriculture related businesses and grant-related enterprises.

In terms of Section XII., Action Agenda, of the existing plan the Commission adopted the following addition:

Action Agenda

Goal: Promote farming and agriculture as part of an overall plan to protect and preserve Sprague’s existing open space plan and to enhance the town’s economic and commercial base through agriculture related businesses.

Action

Lead Agency

Develop zoning regulations that promote agriculture, animal husbandry and agriculture related businesses, such as garden centers.

AG COMM/P&Z

Seek grants and other incentives that promote agriculture, animal husbandry, and agriculture related businesses.

Promote agriculture in Sprague through public awareness campaign.
